"PUPUTAN SQUARE"

Classic urban park made to commemorate the heroic Badung Kings in defense of Dutch invaders in 1906. The monument depicts of heroes brandishing traditional weapons against modern guns. The area is the local's go-to place during lunchtime or with family during sunset hours



"BADUNG MARKET"

Located at Gajah Mada Street, it has become a popular shopping center. The market is opposite one of Bali's biggest temples in Denpasar area. Locals often go here to buy ceremonial items for prayers and festivals

A nature reserve and Hindu temple complex, the forest is a popular tourist attraction with over 10,000 visitors per month. Lies within the village of Padangtegal, it seeks to conserve rare plants and animals as well as to provide a natural laboratory for educational institutions



"BAJRA SANDHI MONUMENT"

Built in 1987, the monument was inaugurated by President Megawati Soekarnoputri on 14 June 2003 as a cultural symbol to immortalize the soul and spirit of Balinese people

Built in 1931 by architect P.J. Moojen, its location is near to former royal palace of Denpasar which had been burnt during Dutch occupation and on east side of Puputan Garden
